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BRANDS HATCH PHOTOGRAPHIC DAY OUT SUNDAY 26th MAY 2013

The Masters Historic Festival returns to Brands Hatch at the end of May for its traditional bank holiday weekend of classic racing action, with historic Formula One cars once again headlining the bill.

The Grand Prix Masters series caters for the evocative Formula One cars raced between 1968 and 1978 and featuring stirring machinery from the likes of Williams, McLaren, Lotus, Tyrrell and Arrows, all running in their period liveries, harking back to the days when Brands Hatch was a regular on the Formula One calendar.

On the fabulous Grand Prix Circuit, spectators will be able to see these priceless examples pushed almost to the limit through the fast and flowing corners which like the cars, remain virtually unchanged from when they raced at Brands in anger.

Further Formula One action will come from the Historic Grand Prix Cars Association, while sports car thrills will be provided by the World Sportscar Masters featuring spectacular Le Mans type prototypes from the 1960s and 70s.

After meeting up at 9am we show you the points on the track that you can get different types of shots from, people are free to do whatever they want but if any tuition is wanted we take those requesting if to a part of the track that allows us to give advise & help with whatever aspect is required, the most frequent request is for help with panning shots.

It's always suggested that a walk around the paddock in the lunch break is a most worthwhile thing to do.

Suggested lens choice would be wide to 70mm or so for the paddock & anything longer than this for around the circuit, an 80 to 200 or so being ideal in most spots., longer if you have it for one or two other points around. Meeting up at the end to chat over a drink whilst looking at some of the shots is optional.

Food & drink, you can take your own or a variety of food & drink is available at Brands.
